Byron recently told us, “So many people are discouraged right now and lonely and honestly not getting sound teaching. We must support organizations that are [biblically] sound.”

He knows Keys for Kids is sound because he and his five siblings were introduced to the *Keys for Kids* devotional by his parents, Dave and Pris Reimer (couple right middle), who were missionaries in the Bahamas. It made a huge difference in his life. “It provided biblical teaching to live with joy and hope in the Scriptures through each day’s trials and blessings [and the reminder that] God is with us,” says Byron. “Keys for Kids stories taught me how God desires to help me as I lean on Him in confidence, casting my cares on Him for He first cared for me.”

He added, “When I was a kid, my mom and dad would order Keys for Kids and hand them out to Bahamian kids. I was always wondering if we were allowed to give so many away,” Bryon said with laughter.

Now, as parents to three children of their own, Byron and Abbie use the Keys for Kids mobile app to help keep their kids focused on God’s Word each day. The free mobile app provides the daily Keys for Kids devotions in text and audio, the Keys for Kids Radio live stream (24/7 radio of faith and fun for kids), and on-demand programs like *Down Gilead Lane*, *Red Rock Mysteries*, and more.

Byron believes Keys for Kids is important to his family’s spiritual growth. “I pray they surrender to the Lord’s desire to save them, grow, and not depart from the truth they were taught through Keys for Kids and His Word. I pray our children can be a beacon of light to generations to come and maybe even partner with organizations like Keys for Kids in their life’s journey.”

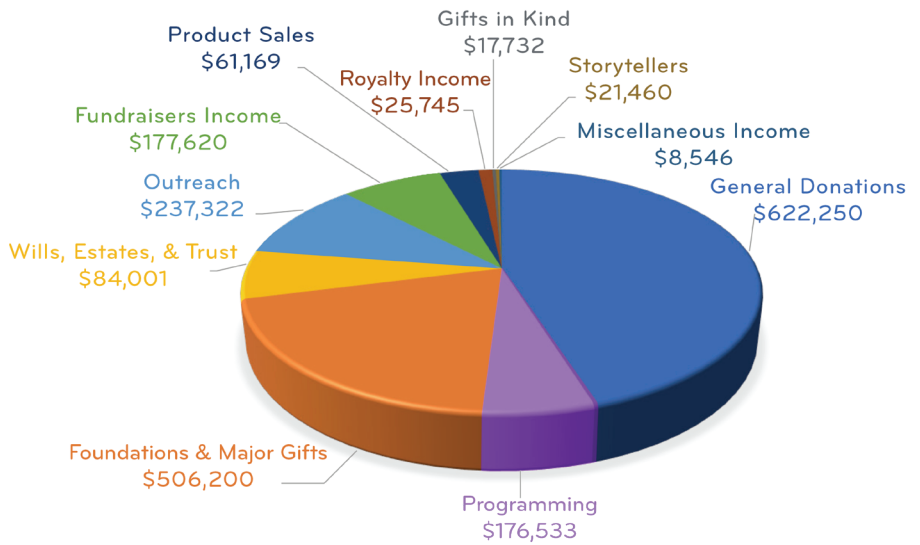

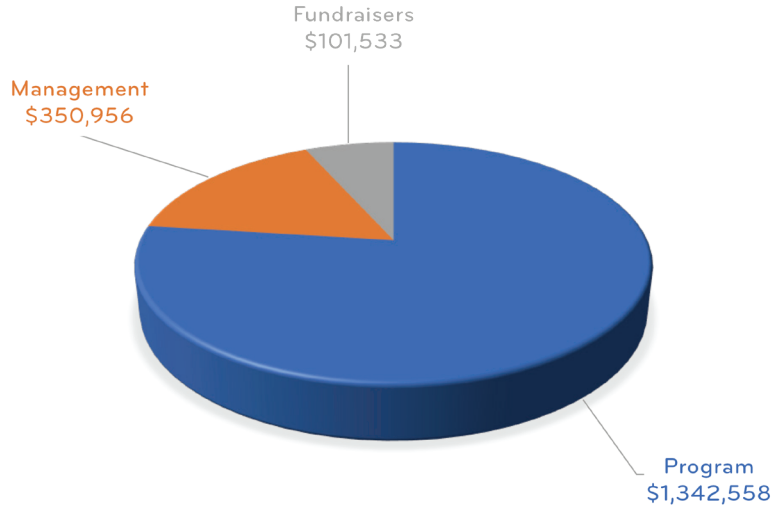
